Place: Congress Center Messe Schweiz, Basel (from the SBB main train station take tram no. 2 direction "Riehen Grenze", to the stop "Messeplatz")

Examination fee: CHF 900.–

Registration procedure

1. Please register by filling in the official web formular (www.sgaim.ch/egim). Any registrations sent by ordinary mail, e-mail, phone or fax will not be accepted.
2. After having received your registration, SSMIG will consult the MedReg register of medical professions (www.medregom.admin.ch) to ensure that you have a Swiss or officially recognized foreign medical diploma. In case you have not yet been registered in MedReg, SSMIG will contact you.
3. If the requirements are met, the candidate receives by e-mail an invoice payable within 10 days.
4. To complete your registration, the payment of the examination fee is required. You will receive a confirmation of acceptance for the examination by ordinary mail.
5. In case your registration is not complete, you will be informed by ordinary mail.

Cancellation policy

The following fees apply in case of withdrawal from the examination:

If written cancellation is received **before May 23, 2019: CHF 75.–**

If written cancellation is received **before June 13, 2019: CHF 150.–**

No reimbursement will be made for withdrawals **after June 13, 2019.**

Administrative charges also apply if examination fee has not been paid yet.
